Methyl Red Test Purpose The Methyl Red Test is a component of the IMViC battery of tests (Indole, Methyl Red, Voges-Proskauer, and Citrate) used to differentiate the Enterobacteriaceae. Biochemical Test IMViC REACTIONS VOGES PROSKAUER (VP) TEST: Principle: While MR test is useful in detecting mixed acid producers, VP test detects butylene glycol producers.
